



Payroll Tax Changes Effective July 1, 2022

British Columbia

The Provincial Labour Sponsored Funds Tax Credit has been removed from the provincial tax calculation.

New Brunswick

On March 22, 2022, the Government of New Brunswick announced an increase to the Basic Personal Amount (BPA), effective January 1, 2022. Subject to approval by the Government of New Brunswick, the BPA will increase from \$10,817 to \$11,720.

Since employees have received a lower BPA for the first six months of the year, a prorated BPA of \$12,623 will apply for the remaining six months commencing with the first payroll in July.

As a client of Deluxe, do I need to do anything?

Yes. Prior to your first payroll with a cheque date in July, you will need to update the Basic Personal Amount for any employees with an Employment Province of NB. To do this:

1. Login to PAYweb
2. Select Employee Profile
3. Select the employee
4. Select Payroll Additional
5. If the Provincial Exempt amount is \$10,817, change it to \$12,623
6. Press Enter to save
